The Tribulation

 The Tribulation is a future period during which God will prepare his people, Israel, for Christ's return and bring severe judgments on the Gentile nations while at the same time bringing many people to himself.

Matthew 24:5-8 – 1st half of 70th week

⁵ For many will come in my name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and they will lead many astray. ⁶ And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not alarmed, for this must take place, but the end is not yet. ⁷ For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom, and there will be famines and earthquakes in various places. ⁸ All these are but the beginning of the birth pains.

- Middle of 70th week
 - From the midpoint through the end of the Tribulation, things change dramatically for the Jewish people.

³⁷ <u>I will make you pass under the rod</u>, and I will bring you into the bond of the covenant. ³⁸ <u>I will purge out the rebels</u> from among you, and those who transgress against me. I will bring them out of the land where they sojourn, but <u>they</u> <u>shall not enter the land of Israel</u>. Then you will know that I am the LORD."

⁷ "Awake, O sword, against my shepherd, against the man who stands next to me," declares the LORD of hosts. ¹⁵ So when you see the abomination of desolation spoken of by the prophet Daniel, standing in the holy place (let the reader understand), ¹⁶ then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains. ¹⁷ Let the one who is on the housetop not go down to take what is in his house, ¹⁸ and let the one who is in the field not turn back to take his cloak. ¹⁹ And alas for women who are pregnant and for those who are nursing infants in those days! ²⁰ Pray that your flight may not be in winter or on a Sabbath.

Matthew 24:21-22 – 2nd half of 70th week

²¹ For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been from the beginning of the world until now, no, and never will be. ²² And if those days had not been cut short, no human being would be saved. But for the sake of the elect those days will be cut short.

Matthew 24:23-26 – 2nd half of 70th week

²³ Then if anyone says to you, "Look, here is the Christ!" or "There he is!" do not believe it. ²⁴ For false christs and false prophets will arise and perform great signs and wonders, so as to lead astray, if possible, even the elect. ²⁵ See, I have told you beforehand. ²⁶ So, if they say to you, 'Look, he is in the wilderness,' do not go out. If they say, 'Look, he is in the inner rooms,' do not believe it.

Matthew 24:27-28 – 2nd half of 70th week

²⁷ For as the lightning comes from the east and shines as far as the west, so will be the coming of the Son of Man.
²⁸ Wherever the corpse is, there the vultures will gather.
